[Verse 1]

Farewell (Em) now, my love, send me (G) off with a (D)kiss
Heave (Em) away, (*straight ahead*), Santi- (D) ano
The (Am) tears are as salty and (D)deep as the (B) sea
But my (Em) sailor's (D) heart is (Em) keen to go

[Chorus]

As (Em) far the wind in our (G) sails may (D) blow
Heave (Em) away, (*straight ahead*), Santi- (D) ano
(Am) Bright the day and the (D) heavens (B) know
We'll be (Em) kings wherever (D) we may(Em) go

[Verse 2]

Hoist (Em) every bit of sail, bring us (G) to full (D) speed
Heave (Em) away, (*straight ahead*), Santi- (D) ano
(Am) Who knows what our (D) fate may (B) be
But the (Em) whole wide (D) world is (Em) ours to see

[Chorus]

[Verse 3]

I'm (Em) fine without a roof and a (G) house of (D)stone
Heave (Em) away, (*straight ahead*), Santi- (D) ano
(Am) Home for me is the (D) sea we (B) roam
And the (Em) roof of stars is (D) mine (Em) alone (Hey!)

[Chorus]

[Verse 4] Repeat Verse 1

[Chorus] X 2 and end.

Some notes:

1. Each Verse should (ideally) be sung by separate individuals with everyone joining in for the Chorus.

2. *Italics* indicate all singers

3. The B Chord can be played using the Em chord shape but moved across to strings 4,3 and 2.
